Dear IRT Co-Chairs,

The Bobcat Marsh bank continued to perform well in 2017 and continues to have credits available. We did not take photos at all the photo points recommended in 2017, as there was a miscommunication regarding who would be completing the 2017 reduced qualitative monitoring. The site is mature and characteristic native species dominate. Ongoing adaptive management to spot treat invasive species is occurring as needed, and constitutes the primary management cost. The 2018 annual report will include photos from identified points and qualitative information regarding cover and condition.
